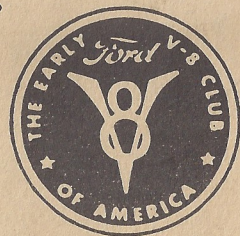
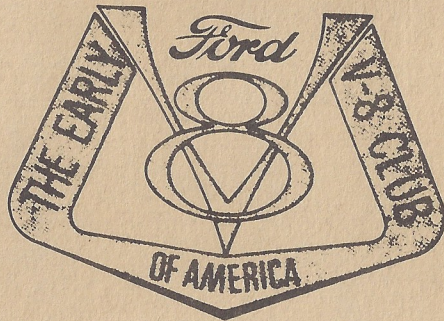

| 3/4 C PEANUT BUTTER | 1 1/2 C RAISINS |
| 1/2 C BRN SUGAR | 1 C FLOUR |
| 1/4 C MOLASSES | 1 TSP BAKING SODA |
| 2 EGGS | 1/2 TSP SALT |
| 1 C SLICED RAW CARROTS | 1/2 TSP CINNAMON |
| 1/2 C WATER | 1 C WHOLE WHEAT FLOUR |

IN A MIXING BOWL, CREAM TOGETHER PEANUT BUTTER BRN SUGAR, MOLASSES, AND EGGS. PUT CARROTS AND WATER IN BLENDER, WHIRL ON HIGH SPEED UNTIL MUSHY. MEASURE 1 C PUREED CARROTS. STIR INTO CREAMED MIXTURE ALONG WITH RASINS. SIFT FLOUR, BAKING SODA, SALT, AND CINNAMON. STIR INTO BATTER WITH FLOUR. MIX ONLY UNTIL BLENDED. SPREAD IN GREASED PAN (LOAF) 9"X5"X3". BAKE IN PREHEATED 325 DEG OVEN 1 HOUR OF UNTIL TOOTHPICK COMES OUT CLEAN. COOL IN PAN 10 MIN..... MAKES ONE LOAF.....

NOTE: 1 CUP APPLESAUCE CAN BE SUBSTITUTED FOR CARROTS AND WATER MIXTURE.....

HERE IS A COPY OF OUR CLUBS' CHARTER APPLICATION IN JULY OF 1971.....

PETITION FOR CHARTER

JULY-1971

DEAR MR. CHAIRMAN:

WE THE UNDERSIGNED MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THE EARLY FORD V-8 CLUB OF AMERICA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 6 OF THE REGIONAL GROUP INFORMATION SECTION OF THE CLUB BY-LAWS, DO HEREBY PETITION THE NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS OF THE EARLY FORD V-8 CLUB OF AMERICA FOR A CHARTER TO ESTABLISH THE FORMATION OF A REGIONAL GROUP TO BE KNOWN AS THE SAN FERNANDO VALLEY REGIONAL GROUP OF THE EARLY FORD V-8 CLUB OF AMERICA.

THE GENERAL AREA AS KNOWN AS THE SAN FERNANDO VALLEY WHICH LIES WITHIN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

THE DIRECT BOUNDARIES ARE AS FOLLOWS: (PLEASE REFER TO ENCLOSED MAP)

- ON THE NORTH BY: RINALDI STREET AND THE COUNTY LINE. (AMENDED SEE FOOTNOTE)
- ON THE SOUTH BY: MULHOLLAND DRIVE.
- ON THE WEST BY: THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY LINE.
- ON THE EAST BY: THE LOS ANGELES CITY-COUNTY LINE.

AT THIS TIME WE HAVE 17 PAID MEMBERSHIPS, AND SEVERAL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES. OUR ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND FIRST CLUB ACTIVITY ARE PLANNED FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 1971. SEVERAL OF OUR MEMBERS ARE OR WERE MEMBERS OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL GROUP AND WILL PROVIDE AN ACTIVE NUCLEUS FOR THE FORMATION OF WHAT WE BELIEVE WILL BE THE LARGEST REGIONAL GROUP IN THE CLUB. WE ALSO WOULD LIKE TO MAKE PLANS TO HOST THE 1972 WESTERN NATIONAL MEET.

THE SAN FERNANDO VALLEY IS RICH IN THE HISTORY OF THE FORD AUTOMOBILE. SEVERAL OF THE FIRST MODEL "A" AND "T" CLUBS WERE FORMED HERE, AS WELL AS MANY OF THE FIRST POST-WAR RACE CARS, EARLY CUSTOM SHOPS, AND MOTION PICTURE LOCATIONS ALL UTILIZING THE FORD V-8 CARS.

SEVERAL OF OUR FORD DEALERSHIPS DATE BACK TO THE EARLY '30's AND '40's AS WELL AS MANY SERVICE STATIONS AND WRECKING YARDS, SO WE HAVE A VAST STORY POTENTIAL FOR INTERESTING ARTICLES IN THE V-8 TIMES. THE SOURCE FOR MEMBERS IS UNLIMITED, AND THERE IS HARDLY A STREET WITHOUT SOME 32 TO 40 VINTAGE FORD SITTING IN A DRIVEWAY OR GARAGE OR BACK YARD.

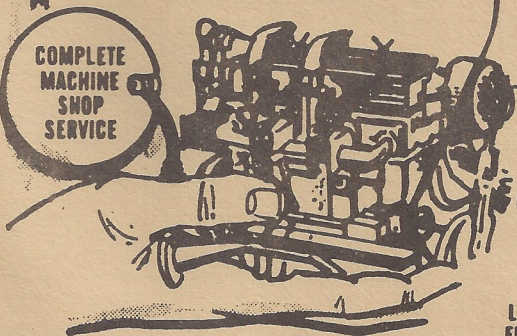

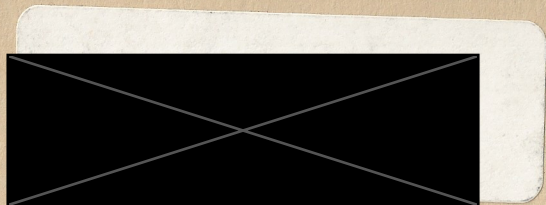
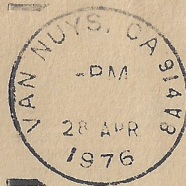
