PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The legislative provision that will enable us to use on the highways YEAR-OF-MANUFACTURE (YOM) license plates requires that there be at least 2,000 applications by December 31, 1984 for the law to go into effect. A \$35 fee is required with the application. If this fee is sent to the DMV and if 2,000 applications are not received, the DMV would not refund the money. But there is a way to be sure you either get a YOM license plate or your money back. The Association of California Car Clubs (ACCC), of which our club is a member, is collecting the applications and fees and holding them so that you are assured of either a YOM license plate or a refund. I'll have applications available at our April 1 meeting, or if you phone me I'll mail you one. For all of us that have been planning to do this, let's do it now -- I just sent my application and fees to the ACCC.

There are specific conditions for getting your YOM license plates:

1. You must have two plates.

- 2. The numbers must not already be in use. You can check with the DMV and if a motor-cycle or truck has your number you can always negotiate with that person to see if he would be willing to have a different plate issued if you paid the reissuing fees.
- 3. The vehicle you are going to put the YOM plates on must be currently registered.

Get your application and fees into ACCC. The check should be made payable to ACCC License Plate Committee Fund and sent to 11660 McLennan Ave., Granada Hills, CA., 91344.
