TECH TIPS


SETTING THE IDLE SPEED ON YOUR EARLY V-8.

THE IDLE SPEED SHOULD BE SET FOR 5 to 7 MILES PER HOUR.

THE SPEED IS EASILY DETERMINED BY MAKING A CHALK MARK
ON THE FAN BELT COUNTING THE NUMBER OF REVOLUTIONS OF
THE FAN BELT FOR FIFTEEN SECONDS. WHEN THE IDLE SPEED
IS CORRECT, THE FAN BELT WILL MAKE APPROXIMATELY 30
REVOLUTIONS EACH 15 SECONDS. USUALLY THE THROTTLE PLATE
ADJUSTING SCREW WILL BE OPEN 24 to 22 TURNS AT THIS SPEED.

SLIGHT ELECTRICAL LEAKS IN CAR DETERMINED BY COMPASS SOMETIMES IN OLDER CARS THERE IS AN ELECTRICAL LEAK, NOT BAD ENOUGH TO BLOW A FUSE, BUT ENOUGH TO RUN DOWN A BATTERY OVER THE WEEK END. IF SUCH A LEAK IS SUSPECTED, YOU CAN MAKE SURE WITH A COMPASS. AFTER TURNING OFF ALL SWITCHES IN THE ELECTRICAL CIRCUIT, PLACE THE COMPASS ON THE HEAVY CABLE GOING FROM THE BATTERY TO THE STARTER SWITCH. IF THERE IS THE SLIGHTEST AMOUNT OF CURRENT PASSING ALONG THE CABLE, THE COMPASS NEEDLE WILL BE DEFLECTED FROM THE NORMAL POSITION.

If we edit the other fellow's write-up, we're too critical;


If we don't, we're usleep.
