
Lincoln cars. In my opinion, all of these programs will be excellent and I hope you will all attend the meetings to hear these speakers.



COMMERCIAL CAR WASHING BEGAN, IT IS BELIEVED, AT AN ESTABLISHMENT IN PORTLAND, OREGON, IN 1912. KNOWN AS THE AUTOMOBILE LAUNDRY, IT WAS HOUSED IN A 60 BY 40 FOOT BUILDING. SIMILAR TO TODAY'S OPERATION, AN AUTOMOBILE, COVERED WITH MUD AND DIRT, WAS DRIVEN IN ONE END OF THE BUILDING. 
PIZZA NIGHT AND CAR SHOW

Participants and spectators after viewing the cars and telling stories, adjourned to the restaurant for pizza, Italian food


and it is rumored a few beers.


