





Outlaw Ford sells for \$250,000

The 1934 Ford V-8 getaway car, used by the outlaw couple Bonnie Parker and Clyde Barrow, has been purchased by the south Las Vegas area Whiskey Pete's Hotel-Casino for \$250,000 from Clyde Wade of Reno, Nev. according to Gary Primm, owner of the casino. The car is currently on permanent display in the hotel's lobby.

Bonnie and Clyde were

ambushed by a special sheriff's unit in Gibsland, La. on May 23, 1934. When the gun battle ended, Bonnie and Clyde were dead and the car was riddled with 167 bullet holes.

"The car looks today just as it did in 1934: bullet holes, broken windows and all," said Primm. "Hundreds of people now stop at the casino daily to see the famous car."




