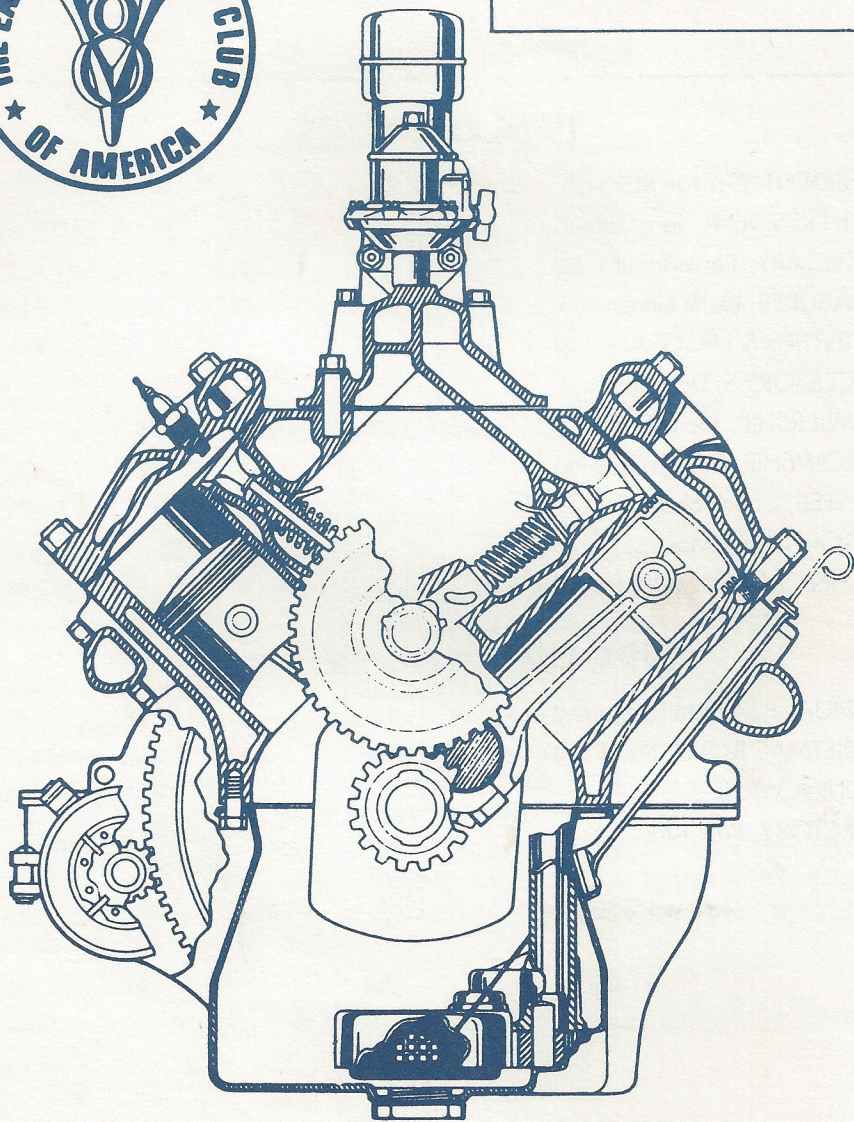

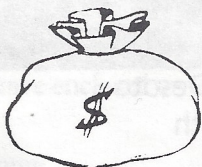
President's Message

Suddenly It's 2007!

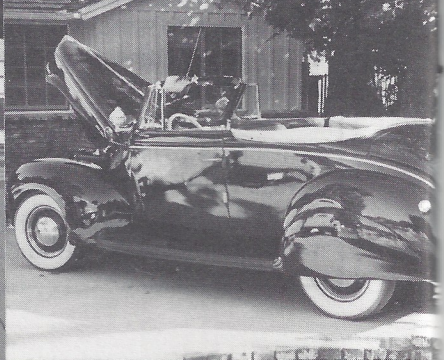
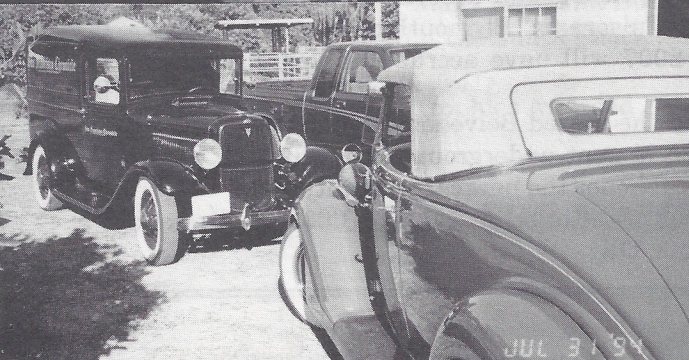
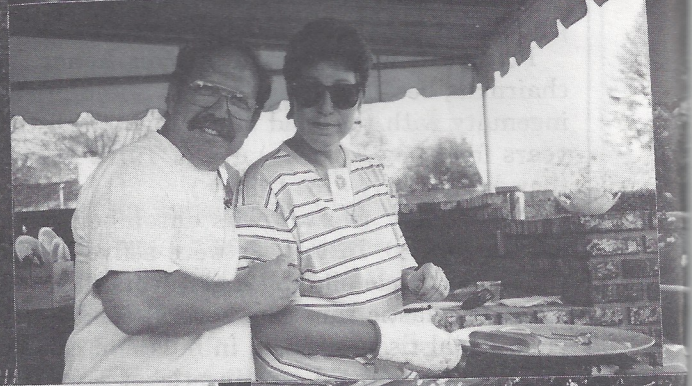
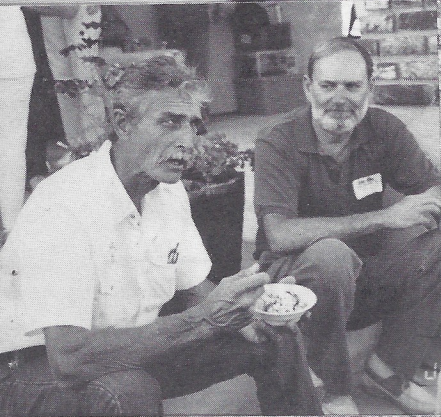
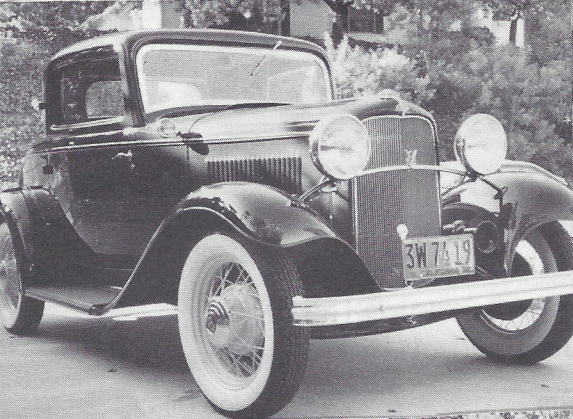
On June 15, 1957, a Plymouth Belvedere V-8 Sport Coupe with Sportone was slowly lowered into a time capsule on the southeast corner of the Tulsa County Courthouse lawn. The occasion was Tulsa's Golden Jubilee.
