The Trophy for the February Meeting will be given to a early FORD 1932-53 product in the parking lot, to be chosen by a drawing, so bring your classics.

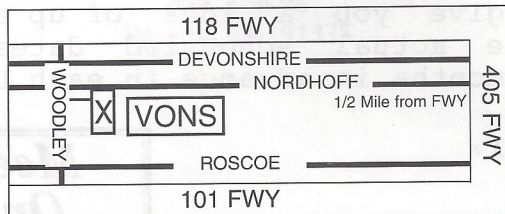
The name badge drawing (JACKPOT \$20.00), to be given to a club member in attendance that is wearing their badge.

Allen is ready and willing to offer his assistance in answering your questions regarding availability and applicability of parts.

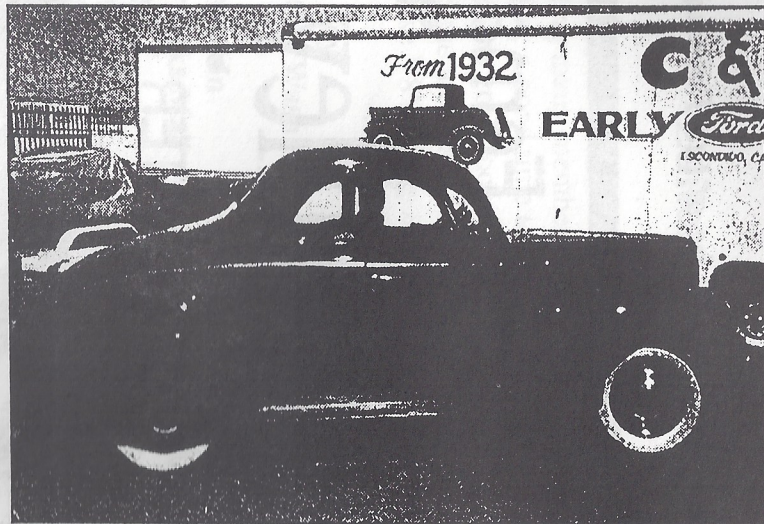
Allen has restored his own 1963 Falcon and is a member of the Falcon Club and Fairlane Club. Also included in our staff

The Bangiolas own the repair end of the business and are always willing to help out with any technical questions customers may have.

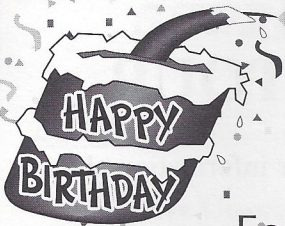
