


MARCH PROGRAM





2 Cups quick-cook oatmeal

1/4 Cup sunflower seeds

1/2 Cup bran flakes

1 Tablespoon flaked coconut

1 Cup assorted dried fruit, chopped

1/2 Cup each: peanut butter and honey

Pre-heat oven to 350°. Place oatmeal and sunflower seeds on a 13" x 9" baking sheet. Bake for 12 to 15 minutes. Stir in bran flakes, coconut, and dried fruit. Place in bowl. In saucepan, over medium/low heat, melt peanut butter and honey. Add to the oatmeal mixture. Press the mixture into a greased 8 inch square pan. Let cool. Cut into bars. Serves 12.


So having bought the present of his dreams, I simply ask, "Please release me from this gift giving guilt trip."


