


## APRIL PROGRAM



Pour 1 jar salsa (mild, medium, or hot) and serve with crackers or chips.


If desired, you may top the salsa with bay shrimp.





We were invited to the Ventura's Palm Springs Tour on the 12th & 13th of April; call Gerry Blackwell at (805) 268-0040 for details.




