



Our recipe this month, provide by Donna is for Ramen Salad.

Ramen Salad

1 Tablespoon toasted sesame seeds 1 Package Top Ramen (Oriental) 1/2 Cup toasted silvered almonds 1/2 Head Napa cabbage 1/4 Cup chopped green onions

Dressing:

1/2 Teaspoon salt 2 Teaspoons sugar 1/2 Teaspoon pepper 1/4 Cup oil 4 Teaspoons rice vinegar 1 Packet Top Ramen seasoning Dressing: Mix and chill; set aside. Salad; Mix onions and cabbage - Add sesame seeds, and almonds. Crush noodles and add just before serving. Add dressing before serving. Serves 6-8.
Variations: Add chicken, turkey,

celery, or water chestnuts.


