



#### June 1997







Our featured V-8ers this month are Don and Mary Durkee. Don and Mary have attended many Ford Nationals, not only the Western meet, but have also attended the Central and Eastern Ford Nationals. Usually in an award winning car.

Don's first car was a 1946 Club Coupe. He traded in a 1948 Whizzer Motor Bike and \$145.00 for the Coupe. It was gray with a nice interior. Don painted it black and had a good

driver.

Don is a second generation Ford man. His Father was a Ford man and Don's first job was at a Ford Dealership, in 1955. Mary provided this months recipe for Fast Bread. I have not tried this recipe, but it sure sounds good.

### FAST BREAD

- 5-6 Cups all-purpose flour (you may substitute whole wheat flour for 1 or 2 cups)
- 2 TBS dry yeast
- 2 TBS sugar
- 1 TBS salt
- 2 Cups hot water (120° to 130°)
- 1 TBS sesame or poppy seeds (optional)

Mix 4 cups flour with yeast, salt, and sugar. Pour in hot water and beat 100 strokes, or 3 minutes with mixer. Stir in remaining flour until dough is no longer sticky. \* Knead 8 minutes. Place dough in greased bowl, cover with a damp towel, and let rise 15 minutes. Punch down. Divide into 2 pieces. Shape into 2 round loaves, and place on a baking sheet. Cut a "X" 1/2 inch deep on the top with a sharp knife. Brush with water, and sprinkle with seeds. Place on middle shelf of COLD oven. Place a cake pan of hot water on the lowest shelf. Heat oven to 400°. Bake 40-50 minutes until golden brown.

\* If your food processor has a dough blade, you cab avoid the hand kneading. Combine dry ingredients in processor. As machine is running, drizzle in water until dough forms a ball. Spin the ball 20 times.

#### "LOOKING BACK"




