absence Chuck Mair.

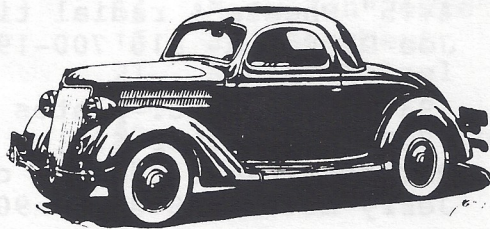
John Kemmerer told the story about the

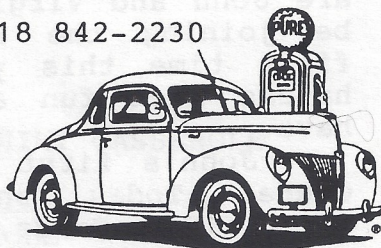

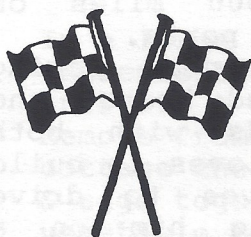

TURKEY ZUCCHINI CASSEROLE

- 1 sm Green Pepper chopped
- 2½ Tbs. chopped onions
- 3 Tbs butter or margarine & flour
- 3 Cups sliced zucchini (¼ inch thick)
- 1 sm carton cottage cheese
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp salt & pepper
- ¼ tsp garlic powder
- 3 Cups cooked turkey
- 1 Cup grated cheese

In a large skillet saute first 4 ingredients until tender. Stir in flour & cook until bubbly. Remove from heat. In large bowl blend cottage cheese, turkey, seasonings, & eggs together, gently combine with vegetable mixture. Place in greased baking dish, & sprinkle with cheese. Bake uncovered at 350° for 30-40 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes before serving. (6 servings)

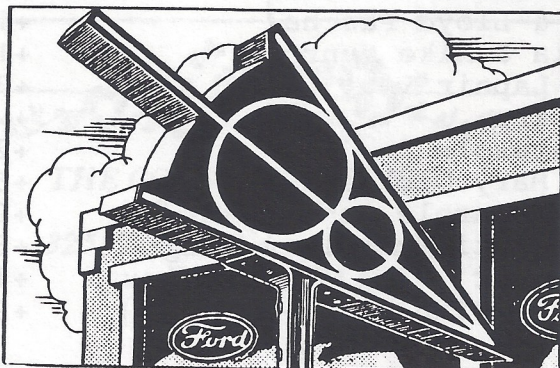

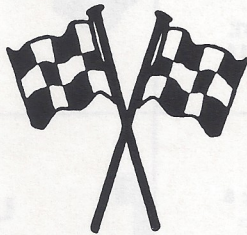

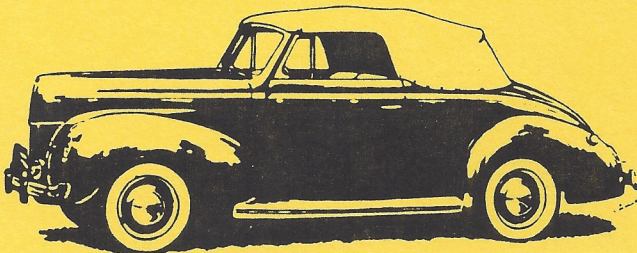
