In 1990 Ron bought a 1962 Corvette but wound up selling the Corvette and the Model T to pay for college for his son and daughter. Ron still has the 1935 which he drives to club events.

Mrs. Fields Oatmeal Chocolate Chip

Cream together:

1 Cup margarine

1 Cup granulated sugar

1 Cup brown sugar (packed)

2 eggs

1 tsp vanilla

Mix together in separate bowl:

2 Cup flour

2 ½ Cup Old Fashioned Quaker Oats

½ tsp salt

1 tsp Baking Powder

1 tsp Baking soda

Add to creamed mixture...

Then add:

1 ½ Cup chopped walnuts

12 oz semi-sweet chocolate chips Drop by rounded tsp on ungreased cookie

sheet. Bake 12 minutes at 350°.

Makes 4 dozen.




