


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

1 cup Brown Sugar
1 cup Applesauce
1/2 cup Vegetable Oil
2 cups Flour
1-1/2 tsp Nutmeg

1/4 tsp Salt
1 tsp Soda

1 Dash of Cloves

1 tsp Vanilla 1 cup Raisins

1/4 cup Chopped Walnuts

Put all ingredients into a mixing bowl, mix until well blended. Pour into 9 x 13 inch pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes.

Frosting

1-3/4 cups Powdered Sugar

1-1/2 tbls Melted Butter

2 tbls Milk 1/2 tsp Vanilla

Mix together all ingredients until smooth, spread over top, and cut into bars.




