



IN MEMORY OF MARTIN LUENING


Martin Luening passed away last month of cancer. Marty has been a long time and active member of The Valley V8's since 1972.

CRANBERRY FRUIT SALAD

- 2 packages (.6 ounce each) sugar free cherry gelatin
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 bag (12 ounces) fresh or frozen
 cranberries
- 1 large apple, peeled and chopped
- 1 large orange, peeled, chopped and seeded
- 1 piece of orange peel (1 inch)
- 1 can (20 ounces) crushed unsweetened
 pineapple undrained

In a bowl, dissolve gelatin in water. Stir in all remaining ingredients. Process in small batches in a blender until coarsely chopped. Poor into a 13 inch X 9 inch X 2 inch dish or 3 quart serving bowl. Chill until set, about 2-3 hours. 16 servings, 47 calories.






