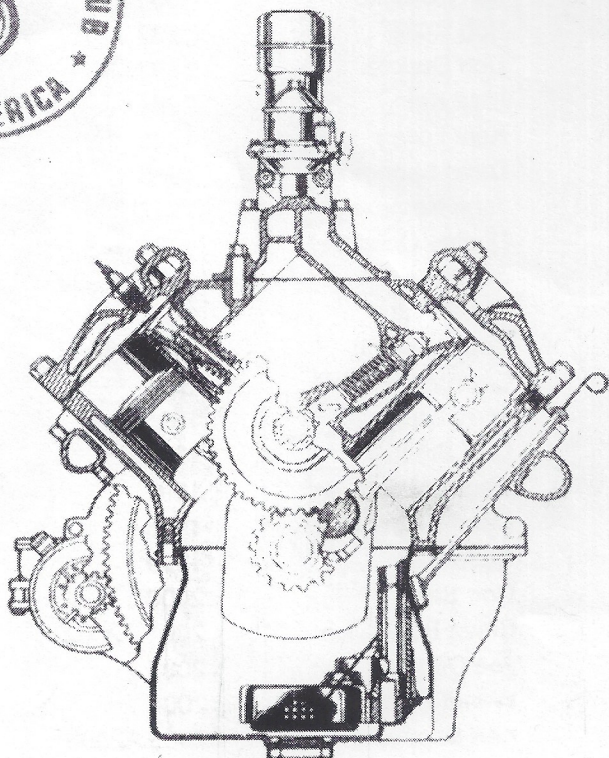

Program for the evening: Don Durkee told a baseball story about grandson Donny. Then brought up granddaughters Christie and Holly, who told about their dogs. Don introduced Glyn Judson and his dog Harry from the Guide Dogs of America. Glyn is a puppy raiser. Harry is his 5<sup>th</sup> dog. He raises and trains the dogs for service. He has the dog from age 7 weeks to 18 months. His job is to introduce the dog to the world. He wears a yellow jacket that says he is in training when he is out. Glyn concentrates on socialization and obedience training.

If the dog has to do its business, the blind person strokes the dogs back to check his position so he knows if he will need to clean up after the dog. The jacket is removed while the dog takes care of business. The dog will go through six months of formal harness training. During the last 28 days he will work with the blind person. The dogs are always Golden Retrievers. They are in service from 6 to 8 years and then retire. July 27 is the next graduation and only half of the dogs in the program will graduate. The half that doesn't graduate are offered to the puppy raiser, then to a list at the school of people who want them. A blind person in need of a dog, signs up, is interviewed, and submits a video of their ability with a cane. Guide Dogs pays for them to come to the school, the dog, the training, the harness and lifetime support.



Isn't it nice to have the kids be able to come to our meetings and be comfortable and enjoy themselves. Glyn Judson gave us ALL a new insight into Guide Dogs and their training.

Front axle nut - tighten to **4 to 6** ft/lbs of torque, then back off one castellation, to achieve a **.004 to .010** hub end play. Be sure to put in the cotter pin

Torque the wheel lug nuts to **75-80 ft/lbs**

Torque the back axle nut to **150/200 ft/lbs**

Add ZDD Plus to your oil each time you change oil, to save your cam and push rods.

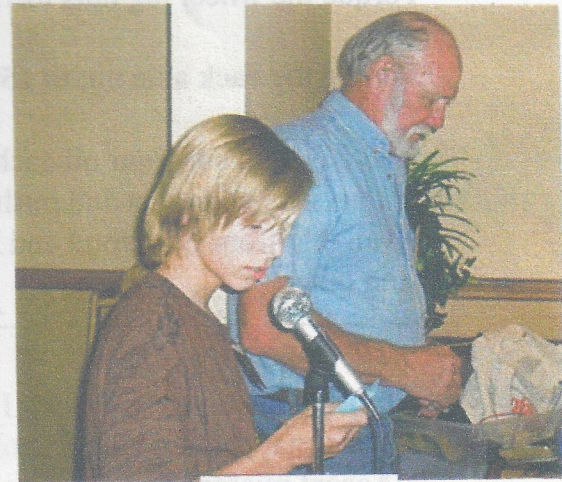

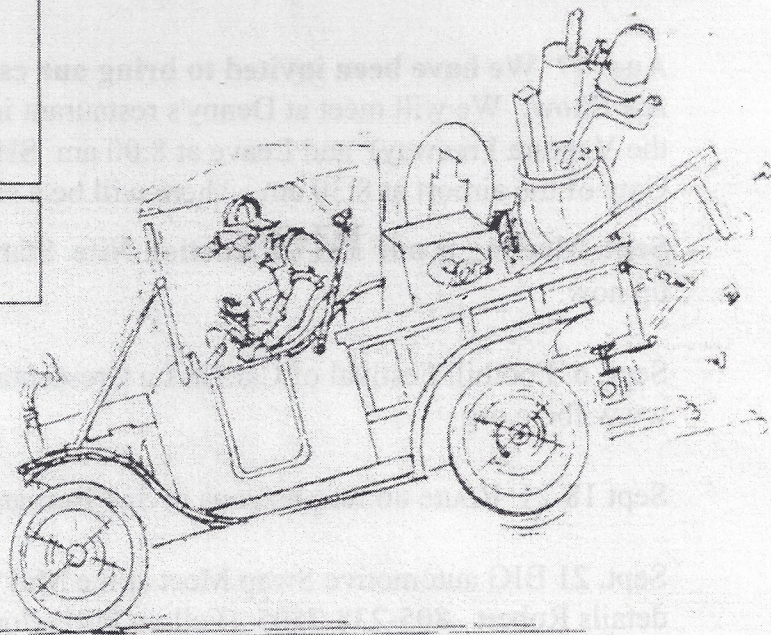

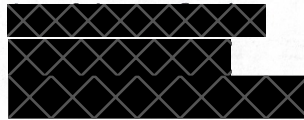
