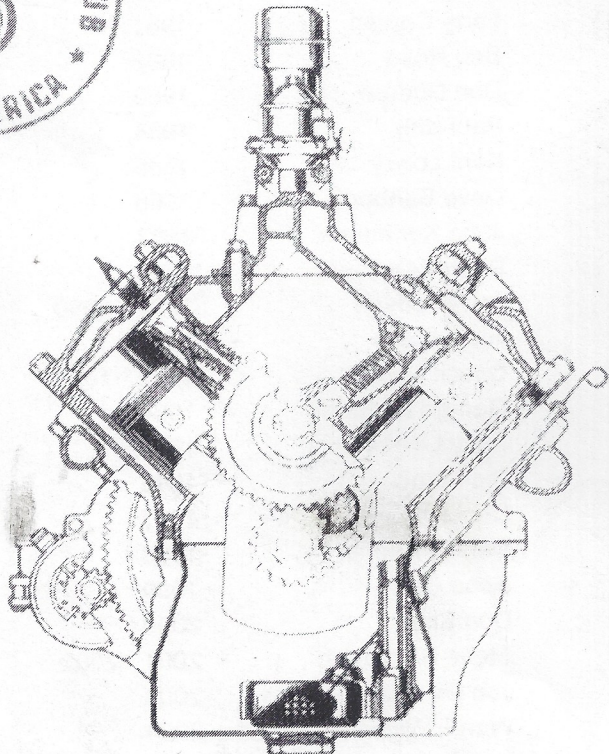
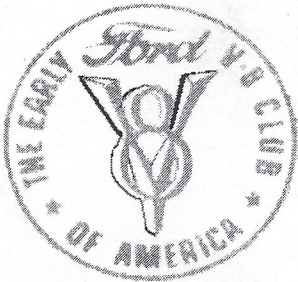

Wendy Potter is stepping down as treasurer so we need a replacement for her. We also need replacements for our tours and program directors. They will, however, be available to help whomever steps forward. We do need someone to fill these positions. Let me know if you are interested in helping out.

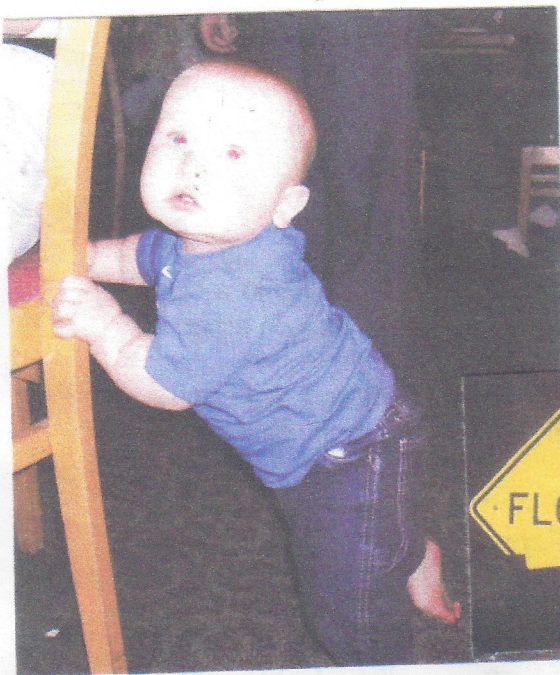
