Oh! That decision to say-- "What" or just nod and smile because, you still didn't understand a word they said.

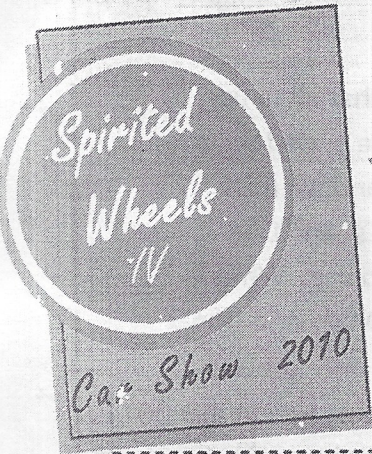
I have a hard time deciphering the fine line between boredom and hunger.

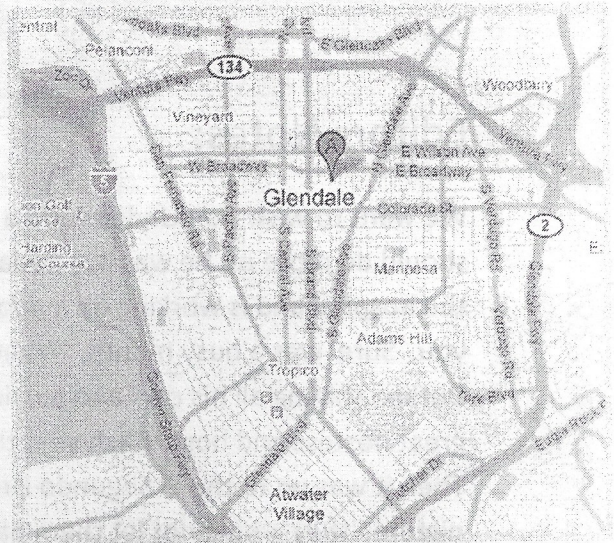

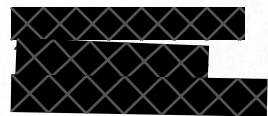
